This 20-week program is broken down into an extensive 12-week classroom and hands-on training, which is completed at the LIUNA Local 493 Training Centre.

The final 8 weeks consist of a paid placement with our signatory contractors.

Membership in LIUNA Local 493 may be offered to pre-apprentices that meet all the terms and conditions stated in the apprenticeship contract and will continue on in Local 493's apprenticeship program to reach the status as Construction Craft Worker.
